### **Vicente Ferrer Foundation's Sustainable and Inclusive approach:**

- 1. **Securing Land Rights:** RDT helps beneficiaries secure land from the government, ensuring they have a permanent and legal place to build their homes.
- 2. **Community Engagement:** Family members and the local community are actively involved in the construction process. This fosters ownership, ensures accountability, and encourages the community to take care of material purchases and maintenance.
- 3. **Prioritizing the Vulnerable:** RDT focuses on women and persons with disabilities, who are often the most marginalized.

Till 2023-24, RDT has built **87,032 homes**, with **93% of homeowners being women**. This has paved the way for dignified housing, independence, and lasting change.





Why Prioritize Women and Persons with Disabilities?

Women and persons with disabilities face unique challenges in rural communities. For them, a safe and secure home means:

- **Protection from Exploitation:** A safe space to live and raise their children.
- Improved Health: Access to proper sanitation and ventilation reduces health risks.
- **Empowerment:** Homeownership increases women's participation in household and community decision-making.
- **Economic Opportunities:** A house can be used as collateral for loans, enabling incomegenerating activities.


